Huge success!!!

- By the numbers:
- Hours: 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- Attendance: 10,000 visitors
 - First cars arrived at 7 a.m.
 - 2,000 people arrived every hour from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.
 - Parking lot again empty by 5 p.m.
 - Visitors from Chicago, out of state and out of country
- Parking: 3,400 cars
- Staff: 1,100 people, including 800 volunteers/employees
- Temperature: 93 degrees
- Music: 30 local musicians performing in welcome tent
- Food: 2,000 meals served by our vendors



Tours and attractions

- 88 buses
 - 4 bus routes
 - 11 bus stops
- 25 tour areas and attractions
 - Neutrino Campus
 - Muon Delivery Ring tunnel tour
 - Muon g-2 magnet/experiment
 - Chicagoland STEM Fair
 - Mr Freeze
- 4 food tents
- 2 coffee tents



Everybody stayed safe

- Temperature: 93 degrees
- Some locations little shade and long lines
- Less than 20 first-aid cases
- Significant medical cases: only 2 (twisted/fractured ankles)
 - No major heat-related problems, though about 25 calls for heat-related assistance

- Preliminary survey results (1,200 responses)
 - 84% rated event good or excellent
 - 63% first visit to Fermilab
 - 70% of those didn't know that Fermilab is open to the public
 - 90% said it is likely or very likely they will visit again
 - 50% found out about the Open House via Facebook
