- Reestablish vital interconnects between international science community to Fermilab engineering and technical teams

  - Adjacent to Wilson Hall
  - Collaborative environment
  - Flexibility of laboratory and office spaces
  - Preserve and strengthen the iconic stature of Wilson Hall
