We had a busy month!




US Secretary of Energy Chris Wright visits Fermilab

Fermilab mourns the passing of John Peoples, third director


John Peoples passed away on June 25, 2025. He was the third director of Fermilab, remembered as a prolific physicist and a hands-on leader.






International Photowalk Contest

- Entries will be exhibited in the gallery this September




The Muon g-2 collaboration unveiled their final results

- Reach of potential readers: 1.72 B




